I am asking that you do not send any peanut or nut containing products to school with your child that will be eaten in the classroom. If your child has eaten peanuts/nuts before coming to school, please be sure your child's hands and face have been thoroughly washed before entering the school.

Please do not send any birthday cakes, cupcakes or other foods containing any type of nuts to celebrate your child's birthday. I will be happy to celebrate your child's birthday in class as long as this exception is made. In addition, please let me know, at least three days in advance when you will be sending food into school in order to celebrate your child's birthday.
